As I mentioned yesterday, I don't think the conditions coming out of the RAA will influence to any degree what you need to cover in the DA, However they will be relative to PWS approval of the works, and may well be duplicated in the Planning Permit.

However I will list them in order that you are aware of what is involved.

1. Flora and Fauna – works should avoid disturbing existing undisturbed areas.
2. Aboriginal Heritage- the need to be aware of your responsibilities under the *Aboriginal Relics Act 1975*. Attached is an Unanticipated Discovery Plan for your information.
3. **Range Extension** – the need to provide for some form of **screening** to prevent overshoot arrows being a hazard to the public use of the fire trail on the southern boundary.
4. Construction waste – the need to remove all construction waste to a registered waste transfer facility.
5. Weed and disease management –to need to comply with the Tasmanian Wash Down Guidelines in relation to machinery entering the site.

Depending on what the intentions are with screening, ie. if construction is involved; apart from including a statement to Council that the Club is aware of it's responsibilities, I doubt if any of the other issues will require any depth of detail. However check that with Council prior.

Give me a call if you need further clarification on the process.
