

PRECIS

MASTER DEVELOPMENT PLAN

FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PARINGA ARCHERY COMPLEX

IN THE

TREVALLYN STATE RECREATION AREA.

STAGE ONE:

- a) Initial target range to be cleared.
170 metre x 40 metre to be levelled, grassed and drained, to provide a range with safety barriers capable to meeting club requirements for at least the first twelve months.
Safety barriers to consist of signs and fences where necessary.
Provision for an initial parking area will be made.

- b) Build a 12 x 6 metre clubroom which will include target storage area, equipment maintenance workshop, kitchen and toilet facilities as per local government building permit.
 - bi) The clubhouse will be built on a reinforced concrete raft foundation, timber framework and clad with split treated pine logs and roofed with corrugated zincalum.
 - bii) Septic tank will be installed to carry waste from kitchen and toilets.

To Be completed by mid 1983.

STAGE TWO:

Improve level of target range by removing soil from area immediately in front of clubhouse to fill the depression at the southern end of ground and enlarge target range to bring it up to tournament standard, top dress and grass entire area.

Landscaping:

Initial landscaping will be to develop a fenced childrens play area and barbecue facilities and also an extensive tree planting programme will be implemented.

Completed - August-September 1983.

Level + enlarge target ground
+ top dress + grass
to bring it up to tournament standard
and utilize the remainder of our lease

STAGE 3 :

Complete landscaping which will include sealed access road and parking area, extend clubroom to include a 35 x 10 metre Indoor Shooting Range, which will provide the club with an all weather training and shooting facility. Install spectator seating for tournaments.

Develop a further leased area for a Field Archery Range.
