Paringa Archers, Presidents Report 2019

Some 15 months ago when I was asked if I would stand for the position of President, I had to give that some serious thought as my first reaction was that it would be a double edge sword, and so it proved to be.

While I was considering my options I spoke to several long standing members and without exception was told the club needed to change, we had to get more forward thinking and we had to get the club functioning within the Associations Incorporation Act 1964; and our own constitution.

I would like to list the major achievements we have made this year.

- 1. We have put the club on a sound footing by implementing the necessary management structures to ensure we operate within the act.
- 2. We have upgraded our constitution to bring it more in line with today's work and management practices, many thanks go to Jeff for doing most of the heavy lifting to make that happen.

- 3. We have upgraded most of the indoor target butts with just 2 left to do, many thanks to Geoff and Barrie for their good work.
- 4. We held a successful open day which for a while gave a big boost to our come n try numbers, thank you to all who helped with that.
- 5. We have purchased more shooting equipment and a ride on mower which greatly helps in the maintenance of the grounds (thanks Paul for the opportunity to get the mower)
- 6. We have identified a weakness in converting our come n try participants into full members of the club, in doing this we re- introduced the Oz-Bow program into the come n try sessions which has been very successful to the point where at the last AST meeting I attended we had the greatest increase in new members of all other Tasmanian clubs combined. We can do more, but it is not a bad start.
- 7. We have changed our membership fee structure to ensure the club can continue to operate funded by only the membership fees, this is a very solid foundation and will enable the club to make improvements in all areas, including equipment and facilities into the future, once again a big thank you to Jeff for the work done on that.
- 8. We also addressed the complex problem of how to get around AA 12 visit come n try policy so we could offer people an alternative path to becoming a member rather than just turn them away or unofficially roll them over into more weeks potentially without insurance cover. To overcome this to a certain extent we have introduced a new membership level, that of Recreational Member, this is not a complete answer, but it is the best we could do given the restrictions we have to work within.

These changes have not come easily to everyone and I am sure there are some members who would prefer the club to remain as it was.

But you see it cannot, the club is an incorporated body and not a social club, we as members have a responsibility to ensure the club functions within the act and our own constitution.

The club must also be relevant in today's social and sporting entertainment field, if the club does not evolve and move forward, attract new people to the sport and increase membership then it withers and dies as a flower without water.

I would like to say something about our executive committee members and our volunteers.

I have been in the unfortunate position this year where I have experienced our executive committee members referred to in not the most complimentary terms, surely, we are better than this.

Our executive committee members are all volunteers who work hard to do a job that is required by our constitution, to make sure our members are protected within the framework of the Associations Incorporation Act and that the club functions to the best advantage of all members. There is no elevated status change when becoming an executive committee member, just more work and more responsibility.

In talking about volunteers, I would like to thank all our come n try volunteers who not only had to cope with the come n try sessions, some of which had large numbers, but this year have also implemented the OZ Bow program as well. That is a lot of extra but worthwhile work which has resulted in a noticeable growth in membership, well done everyone.

In addition to that I am pleased to say it looks as though we will start next year with 4 full teams of 4, so thank you to all those additional members who have joined the teams.

Remember every volunteer hour is of equal importance no matter what the task, without those people willing to give of their time and experience many organizations including ours would not function.

Lastly I would like to thank the members of the executive committee who have worked so hard during this last year and also put up with me for the year, I know I can get carried away with ideas and need to be restrained sometimes, but I work on the basis one idea is better than no ideas.

I note with great pleasure we now have a Face Book Members Lounge where members can chat amongst themselves leave messages etc, I look forward to learning how to use that if anyone cares to teach an old dog new tricks.

It has been a tough year and at times I have wondered why I do this, but as I walk around and listen to the banter and competitive spirit among members and the chatter and cheering on the come n try line as people hit the gold after trying so hard, I am encouraged by what a senior member said to me recently

"I think the club is moving in the right direction" he said, and he is right.
