Hi Jeff

Thank you for the email.

The height would be around 20ft which I think is the length of the aluminium poles.

At this stage I have only thought of 1 archer at a time, as there would be six popinjays on 1 pole to start with to see how it goes.

I have thought the arrows would be Flu Flu as per the mini clout with blunts attached.

I would think the same as the mini clout, longbow, barebow recurve with a maximum poundage about 40lbs.

We would shoot from the shooting line with the popinjay set up at 20mtrs, I can't see the the arrows reaching further than with the mini clout and probably less with the blunts added, the elevation would be similar to mini clout and most of those will not reach the bank.

Your suggestion of using an old target butt to support the pole sounds good, we could position it roughly in line with the clout at 20 metres.
